Our City of Milwaukee 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan work is entering the next phase. We completed our survey and focus groups by talking with City NSP organizers who have helped us tremendously with survey collection and community outreach. We went over the preliminary survey results and collected feedback on the process and what they learned from talking with residents. Thank you all for work!

We also learned about Vision Zero and Milwaukee's goal to end traffic fatalities by 2037. Both the County and the City have committed to this vision, which focuses on making infrastructure changes and doing education campaigns to reduce reckless driving and speeding.
